

Richmond Quilters' Guild Challenge 2020-MAQF

An invitation has been extended to the guild for a special exhibit at the Mid-Atlantic Quilt Festival in February 2020. The theme for this years challenge will be "**On the Road Again!**" All guild members are invited to submit an entry to the challenge using the criteria as outlined below:

1. Keeping the challenge theme of "**On the Road Again**" in mind, create a scenic quilt.
2. You may use any techniques that you wish. Traditional piecing, paper piecing, appliqué of any kind, etc. You are encouraged to try a technique which is new to you.
3. Size range: The quilt can be no larger than 35"x35". Any shape is acceptable.
4. Your entry must have three layers including batting and must be quilted by machine or hand.
5. The quilt must have a hanging sleeve and a label on the back that includes both the name of the quilt and the maker of the quilt. If your quilt is quilted by someone other than yourself, that information must be included as well.
6. **Submission deadline** for the registration form is November 22, 2019. Form must include a brief description of your quilt that will hang with your quilt during the show. Quilts **do not** have to be turned in this date, however, you must submit the form with the information about your challenge quilt by this date.

Some ideas to get you going.....

Create a road trip remembrance quilt.

Did you discover a place in your travels that you would like to capture the memory in a quilt?

You may submit more than one entry if you're so inclined.

Allow your imagination to run wild!

You just might want to include a Willie Nelson inspired design from his memorable hit song!
